

CURRENT SITUATION, MEASURED IMPACTS & RESULTS

- Part of the **human resources** were already hired: 3 senior officers (action A1);
- Internal teams capacitation: training and participation in the Kickoff meeting of LIFE14 Capacity Building projects, in Brussels (january); Info Day, in Spain (may); LIFE NCP Training, in Brussels (june) (actions A2 and A7);
- INTER LIFE PT 2016 Event (november) (action A4);
- 1st work session with co-financers and crowdfunding platforms (march) (action A5);





CURRENT SITUATION, MEASURED IMPACTS & RESULTS

- Public sessions followed by workshops, each one with approximately 200 e 100 participants respectively, in 5 different locations including Madeira and Azores

 (anonymous inquiry about the workshop: when asked if they would recommend the training, the answer was almost 100% positive) (actions A6 and A7);
- «Open Desk» events in Lisbon and Oporto: 17 entities registered but only 8 use it in fact (action A8);





CURRENT SITUATION, MEASURED IMPACTS & RESULTS

- Specialized support to project proposers: 9 entities registered but only 6 use it in fact (action A9);
- Project web site: procedure awarded (action C1);
- LIFE Magazine: procedure awarded (action C2);
- Projet management: partnership protocols: all signed; UE financial contribuition to partners: all transfered (action B1 and D1);
